### Sticky Knowledge

#### Why are special and sacred stories important?

Storytelling has existed since time began. Stories are evident in every culture and from every age. Stories may not all be historically accurate or even true, but they help to bind communities together and may appear in many forms. Stories may have different meanings, e.g. moral, religious, personal. This means that they can teach people very important lessons.

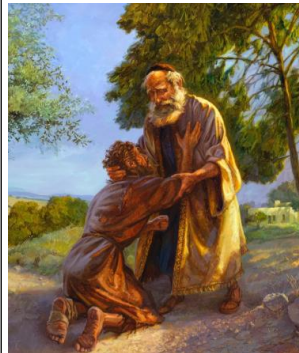


#### Judaism.

Moses was an important leader of the Jewish people. Moses grew up in an Egyptian palace as a royal prince. Moses heard the voice of God from a burning bush asking him to lead the Israelites out of enslavement to the promised land. After three months of traveling, the Israelites arrived at the foot of Mount Sinai, God called Moses to meet him at the top of the mountain. God gave Moses ten important laws. These were called the Ten Commandments.

#### Christianity.

When Jesus wanted to teach crowds of people an important message, he often told stories called parables. The parables are found in the new testament, in the Gospels. A parable is a story based on everyday life that holds a deeper meaning.
