Star Words	Definition
Senses	A sense is a way our bodies understand the world around us.
Rhythm	Patterns of sound consisting of shorter and longer notes.
Tempo	How fast or slow the music is.
Note	A symbol used to write down a musical sound.
Instrument	Is any object that produces sound and can be used to create music (including voice).

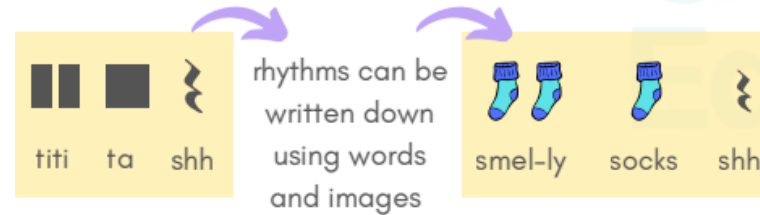
