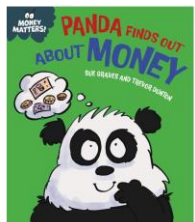
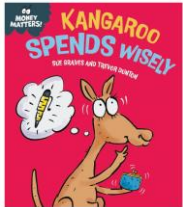

- Money is used to pay for or buy things.
- Money comes in notes and coins.
- You can pay for things in different ways e.g. using notes and coins, a debit card or a phone.

- Some money is spent on things we need e.g. food, bills, medicine.
- Sometimes money is spent on things we want e.g. toys, sweets, days out.
- Sometimes we can't have what we want straight away and we have to save for it.
