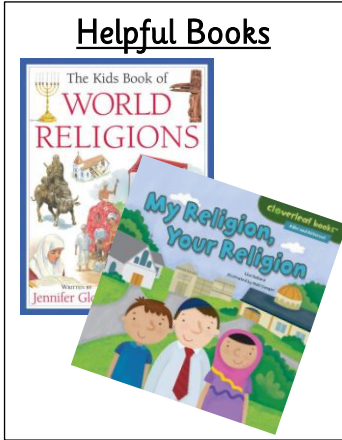

Christians have a sacred text called the ‘Bible’ and worship in a Church.
