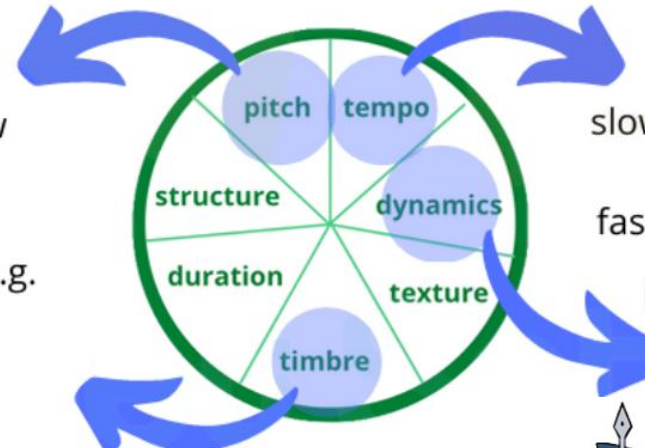


So and mi are the names given to the notes G and E. Most simple nursery rhymes are based upon it. In this unit, children also learn to sing and play 'la', the note A.
