

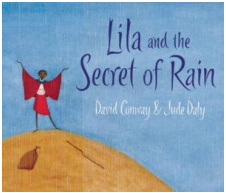
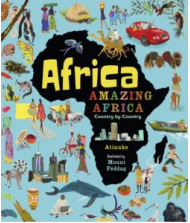

- Create your own world map and label the continents and oceans.

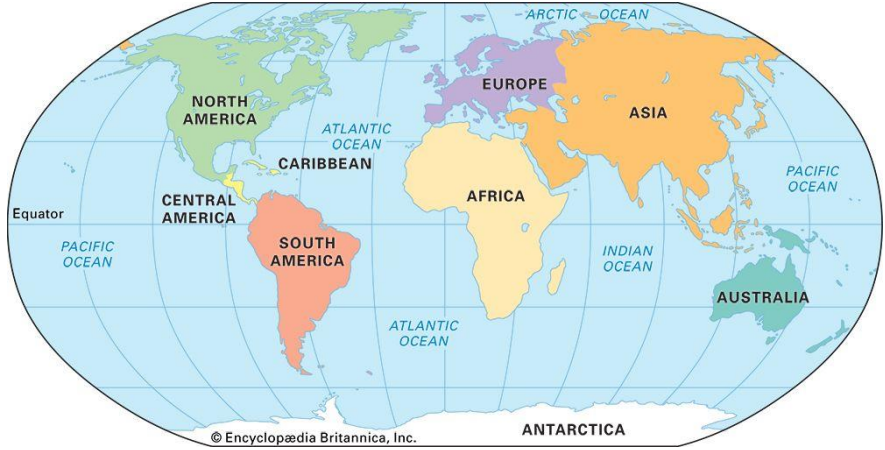
