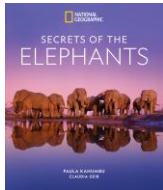

- Jane Goodall was the first person to study chimps in the wild.
- She set up the Jane Goodall Institute to learn about chimpanzees and to encourage people to protect the environment for living things.
- Wangari Maathai created The Green Belt Movement which encouraged women to plant trees to help with deforestation.
- She was the first African Woman to win the Nobel Peace Prize.
- Paula Kahumbu is an elephant expert who campaigned to protect elephants and rhinos from illegal poaching.
- She spent many years learning about elephants and used her knowledge to make nature films and TV shows teaching others.
