Home Learning Ideas

What to do:

- ★ **Roll and stop a ball**
Roll a ball to someone.
Can you stop it with your hands?
- ★ **Practise hitting a balloon**
Keep the balloon in the air by hitting it with your hand, a bat or a rolled-up sock.
- ★ **Run around objects safely**
Set up some cones or toys.
Run around them as carefully as you can.
- ★ **Play throwing and collecting games**
Throw the ball to a partner and collect it together. How many can you collect?
- ★ **Take turns and have fun!**

Sticky Knowledge

Striking and fielding games involve hitting a ball into space and working together to collect it. In this unit, children will learn to strike a ball, run safely, stop and collect a ball and work as part of a team. Children will begin to follow simple rules and take turns in games.



I can strike a ball into space.
Watch the ball carefully.
Use the bat to hit the ball forwards.



I can run safely after hitting a ball.
Run around the cone carefully.
Watch where other people are.



I can stop and collect a ball.
Move towards the ball.
Use two hands to pick it up.



I can return the ball to help my team.
Carry or roll the ball back quickly.
Aim towards the hoop or base.



I can take turns in games.
Wait safely for my turn.
Share equipment kindly.



I can work as part of a team.
Spread out in space.
Help my teammates.
