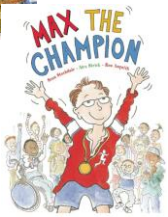
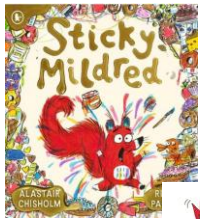

Star Words	Definition
Batter	The person who hits the ball.
Fielder	A player who stops and collects the ball.
Score	To get points in a game.
Space	An empty area away from fielders.
Track	To watch and follow the ball carefully.

Home Learning Ideas

Field to Stop

What you need: two players, a marker and a ball or pair of rolled up socks.

How to play:

- Place the marker in a space and stand next to it.
- One player is the batter with the ball, the other player is the fielder.
- The batter rolls the ball into the space and then scores points by sitting down and standing up (one point for each time they do this).
- The fielder runs to collect the ball, holds it in the air and shouts 'stop!'.
- Batter to confirm their score and then change roles.
- Play again, with throwing.

Sticky Knowledge

Striking and fielding games are games where one team tries to score points and the other team tries to stop them scoring. In this unit, pupils learn to strike a ball into space, collect and return a ball quickly and work as a team. Pupils will develop batting and fielding skills, follow rules and begin to use simple tactics in games.



I can strike a ball into space.
Watch the ball carefully.
Use the centre of the bat.



I can strike a ball further using a stronger swing.
Swing the bat smoothly.
Follow through after hitting.



I can track and collect a ball.
Move towards the ball.
Scoop the ball up with two hands.



I can return the ball quickly to stop scoring.
Throwing the ball back is quicker than running with it.
Aim towards the target or base.



I can score points by running safely.
Strike then move quickly.
Watch where fielders are standing.



I can work as part of a team.
Spread out when fielding.
Encourage teammates and take turns fairly.
