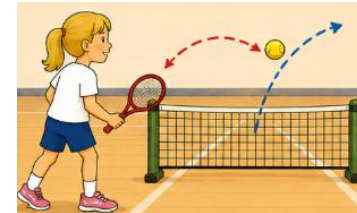
Net and Wall games



Star Words	Definition
Rally	Keeping the ball moving between players.
Opponent	The person or team you play against.
Serve	Starting the game by sending the ball over the net.
Position	The place where you stand in a game.
Volley	Hitting a ball before it bounces.

Sticky Knowledge

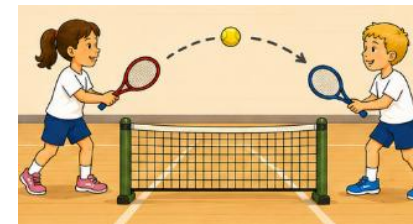
Net and wall games are games where players send a ball or object over a net or against a wall. The aim is to score points by making it difficult for an opponent to return the ball. In this unit, pupils will develop sending and receiving skills, movement, teamwork and simple tactics while using rackets, balls and other equipment.



I can watch the ball to prepare to hit it.
Track the ball carefully.
Get into position quickly.

I can use the correct amount of power.
Send the ball carefully to my partner.

I can rally using a racket or my hands.
Return the ball with control.
Try to keep the rally going longer.



I can use a ready position to react quickly.
Stay balanced and ready.
Move quickly to return the ball.

I can apply simple tactics against an opponent.
Aim away from my opponent.
Choose where to send the ball.

I can score points and follow rules.
Keep score fairly.
Follow the rules of the game.

Catch Tennis

What you need: two players, three markers and a ball

How to play:

- Create a net through the middle using your markers.
- Stand on either side of the net.
- Take turns to throw underneath over the net.
- Try to catch the ball before it bounces twice.

To win a point:

- Partner throws the ball and it bounces on their side of the net first.
- Partner does not catch the ball before it bounces twice.
