**Sticky Knowledge**

How to stay safe at home

Only cook with an adult. Don't use the oven by yourself.

Tell an adult if you spill anything so it can be cleaned up.

Only use sharp knives with an adult.

Don't touch sockets with wet hands or put things in sockets.

Only use kitchen chemicals without an adult.

Keep electrical equipment away from water.

Don't run on the stairs.

Don't play with matches or lighters.

Don't answer the door without an adult.

**Coastguard**

- Where are you?
- What has happened?
